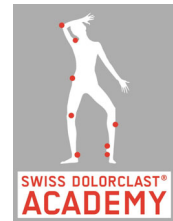
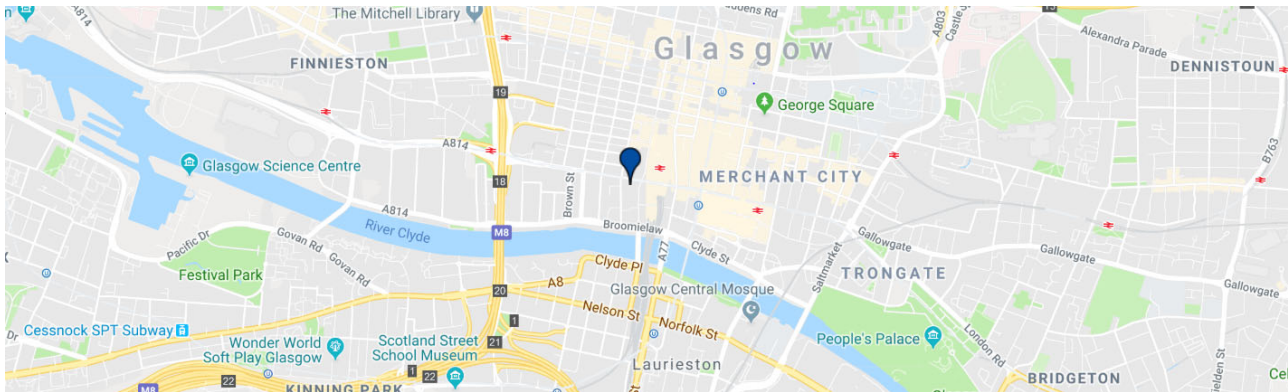

The iconic Radisson Blu Hotel, Glasgow is ideally located in the city center, just opposite from the Central Railway Station.



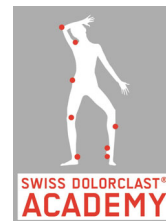
HOW TO GET TO THE HOTEL

Glasgow Airport

Glasgow Airport is 13.4 kilometres from the hotel (about 20 minutes by taxi). When arriving, the airport bus is a quick and affordable option to reach the hotel. Leave the bus at Central Station and take a short walk down Hope Street to find the hotel.

A short walk connects you with the city's network of bus, urban rail and underground transport systems. The tourist bus even stops at the hotel doors. Buchanan Bus Station and Glasgow Queen Street rail station are a less than a 10-minute walk away.
